Agenda Item Title: Discussion of Change in District Leadership
Background:
The Classified Senate at College of the Canyons represents the classified staff and works to promote communication, collaboration, and shared governance on campus. Recently, the Classified Senate, along with the Classified Union (CSEA 725), the Academic Senate, the Academic Union (COCFA), and the Administrator Leadership Group (MLA), issued resolutions and statements regarding recent changes in district leadership. For the first time in its history, the Classified Senate voted to issue resolutions of no confidence in Trustees Fred Arnold and Sharlene Johnson and expressed strong support for CEO and President David Andrus. These actions were taken following the September 10 Board of Trustees meeting, during which President Andrus was placed on administrative leave despite widespread public comment and resolutions urging support. Michael Monsour, President of the Classified Senate, will share the Senate's perspective, provide context, and answer questions from the ASG.
